

Five Important Things You and Your Faith Community Can Do Today to Protect Immigrants and DACA Recipients

- 1) **Many DACA students are being required to re-register for DACA status** before Oct. 5, 2017 if their status expires before March 5, 2018, even though they face deportation on March 5, 2018. The cost to re-register is \$495 and unfortunately, some DACA recipients just don't have the funds to pay it. The New Sanctuary Movement of Atlanta is helping DACA students at Freedom University who are having financial difficulties by providing them with the DACA re-register fee. *We are asking your faith community to help raise funds for at least ONE student.* (Checks should be made out to "Freedom University" and mailed to Columbia Presbyterian Church, 711 Columbia Drive, Decatur, GA 30030)
- 2) **Call and write** your U.S. representatives and senators and ask them to support a clean DREAM act without any strings attached.

Call your Senators TODAY. Tell them to protect Georgia's Dreamers.

- 3) **Offer your services to drive a DACA student or immigrant** whose driver's license in Georgia has been suspended to appointments (counseling, legal, medical, etc.) and for basic support (i.e. grocery store).
- 4) **Sign up for the Rapid Response Network.** The Network exists to mobilize supporters who may be available on short notice as an observer at court hearings, to observe an ICE raid, or other times when their presence may be helpful. No one will be expected to respond to all alerts. Contact us for more information about signing up for the network.
- 5) **Volunteer at a legal aid/know-your-rights clinic** to empower immigrants to understand their constitutional rights as well as create legal documents to safeguard their families.
