

### **Information on voting after a felony conviction in Georgia:**

While it is true that individuals convicted of a felony are ineligible to vote while in prison, on parole, or on probation, **voting rights are automatically restored upon completion of all supervised release, and payment of all fines and fees associated with the felony.**

**Ex-offenders should re-register to vote.**
