

How to Vote in Person in Georgia

- 1) Check your voter status:** You can do this by visiting the My Voter Page on the Georgia Secretary of State's website: www.mvp.sos.ga.gov

Enter your information in the right-hand box and click the "submit" button. This will take you to your voter page. If your status is listed as "active," you are registered! If your status is not listed as "active," please call the Voter Protection Hotline at **888-730-5816**.

- 2) In-person early voting is from Monday, Oct. 12, through Friday, October 30.**

Not all early voting locations have been announced for the November 3 (presidential) election, but early voting generally takes place at your county board of elections office and **not** at your regular polling place. Once they are announced, you can find your early-voting locations on the [Georgia Secretary of State's My Voter Page](#).

Remember to bring a valid state or federal government issued photo ID, including a free ID Card issued by your county registrar's office or the Georgia Department of Driver Services (DDS). Other valid forms of ID include:

- A Georgia Driver's License, even if expired
- Valid employee photo ID from any branch, department, agency, or entity of the U.S. Government, Georgia, or any county, municipality, board, authority or other entity of this state
- Valid U.S. passport ID
- Valid U.S. military photo ID
- Valid tribal photo ID
- State University ID

- 3) Election day is Tuesday, November 3.** If you haven't yet voted by November 3, please wear a mask and go vote in person on election day. You must be in line by 7 pm to cast your vote. Bring your valid photo ID (see above list), a drink, and a snack (lines may be long!).

If you choose to vote on November 3, you will vote at your assigned voting location. If you are unsure of where that is, check your [My Voter Page](#) to confirm. If you run into any problems at the polls (for example, if you are told you are ineligible to vote) ask to cast a provisional ballot, and then call the voter protection hotline after doing so. They will help you sort it out. **888-730-5816**
